

Sikkim Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. (A Government of Sikkim Undertaking) is organizing a trek- programme with a brand name of “**Singhalila Rhododend Trek**” w.e.f 24<sup>th</sup> March to 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2010 as a part of Sikkim “**Singhalila Rhododendron Festival 2010**” at Hilley, West Sikkim.

The main festival is being organized by Daramdin Tourism Development Society, West Sikkim .

The itinerary of the trek programme is as follows:

Day 1 <sup>st</sup> -	24 <sup>th</sup> March, 2010 -	Report at Hillay (Height 8000 ft.) Night Halt (Tented accommodation)
Day 2 <sup>nd</sup> -	25 <sup>th</sup> March, 2010 -	Departure Barsey Night halt at Deonigaley(Ht 10000 ft.)
Day 3 <sup>rd</sup> -	26 <sup>th</sup> March, 2010 -	Trek to Thulodhap Chok (Height 10000 ft) Night halt
Day 4 <sup>th</sup> -	27 <sup>th</sup> March 2010 -	Trek to Kalizar(Height 12000 ft.) Night halt
Day 5 <sup>th</sup> -	28 <sup>th</sup> March 2010 -	03.00 a.m. trek to Phoktey (13000 ft) to view the majestic Mt. Kanchenjunga, Sun rise etc. leading Chewa Bhanzang to Uttery at Hee- Bermiok – Night halt at Village Tourism home stay.

**Rate : Rs.3,500/- per pax**

**Which includes:**

1. Tented accommodation with food
2. Entry fee for the Barsey Rhododendron Sanctuary

**Excludes:**

1. The fee for electronic gadgets like still & video camera etc
2. Helicopter charges

- The trekkers below 14 years of age shall not be allowed.
- The students shall be rendered 50% concession on the trek fee subject to production of student identity card / proof.

- Since the trek is being organized within Barsey Rhododendron sanctuary, protected area; all the trekkers are suggested to follow the protected area **Code of Conduct**.
- Helicopter service will be available from Gangtok to Dodak, West Sikkim to facilitate the trekkers. A joy ride by helicopter at a nominal rate of Rs.1000 per person from Dodak helipad to Versay hill top shall be conducted w.e.f. 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of March, 2010.
